MPavilion 2017 is the fourth in a series of architect-designed temporary pavilions commissioned by the Naomi Milgrom Foundation. Designed by OMA's Rem Koolhaas and David Gianotten, MPavilion 2017 is a new kind of civic space for Melbourne—a place for you to meet, talk, think and experience.
